

IHS Standards Expert Tech Tip – Icon Descriptions


Enhancements for subscribers of IHS Standards Expert and IHS Standards Expert with Goldfire include new and updated icon-driven tools that clearly identify content access and important document information.

3D1 3D1	The AIA/NAS 3D Model solution is available for AIA/NAS 3D Model subscribers. If the 3D icon is greyed out, it indicates the solution is available, but not viewable by non-subscribers.
③	This icon indicates that the document is in a language other than English.
	This icon indicates that an Account Note has been created for the document.
	A red page icon indicates that a Redline document is available if a user subscribes to Active and Historical or an Active/Historical collection. If not, the icon is greyed out.
A	This icon indicates that the document has Digital Rights Management (DRM) placed on it by the Standards Development Organisation authors, and requires the FileOpen plug-in to view the document.
=	A shopping cart icon indicates that the document is not in the user's subscription. Clicking on the icon will present a user with purchasing options.
	Click on this icon to view the document; icon also indicates that the document is in a user's subscription. The document number may also be clicked on to view the document.
9	This icon indicates that the document is available as a Document Preview version only and that it is not in the user's subscription.
